Major determinants of weighty pets:

- Overfeeding
- Breed
- Age
- Neutering/spaying
- Medical conditions
- Overeating

Key principles to manage weight:

- Provide the right foods and follow feeding guide (including neutered/spayed pets)
- Watch for "unauthorised" feeding and scavenging, and give treats sparingly
- Enable appropriate levels of exercise



#### UNDERWEIGHT

- Ribs & pelvic bones visible
- Waist is very obvious
- Can not feel any fat on the rib cage



#### IDEAL

- Ribs & spine bones are not visible, but can be felt
- Waist is obvious
- A small bit of fat on abdomen but not sagging on the side view



#### OVERWEIGHT

- Ribs & spine not easily felt
- No waist from top view
- Abdomen is fat, distended & sags on the side view
